Cardinham Challenge: Purpose

The Cardinham Challenge wholeheartedly supports pupils' spiritual, moral, social, and cultural (SMSC) development. The challenge supplements the SMSC development that takes place in school and provides an opportunity for pupils to reflect and build on their development independently. The Cardinham Challenge recognises the significance of nurturing pupils' holistic growth. By emphasising spiritual, moral, social, and cultural aspects, the challenge helps shape well-rounded individuals. We have consciously formatted the challenge in a similar way to the Duke of Edinburgh (D of E) award in that bronze, silver and gold awards are given out to successful participants. We hope that this will inspire pupils to take part in the D of E as pupils have taken part in a similar challenge.

<u>Aim</u>

As we move into our second year of the Cardinham Challenge, our aim is to increase the number of pupils taking part and achieving a certificate. We hope that, by taking on board the feedback from the Family Forum, participation will increase. Last year's figures were:

- 10 bronze certificates = 13% of pupils
- 11 silver certificates = 14% of pupils
- 9 golds certificates = 12% of pupils
- 30 participants = 39% of pupils took part

We can do this!
