Attendance Policy Update

Since the beginning of this term, we have been using the Truro and Penwith Academy Trust Attendance Policy. You can find a copy of this policy by clicking on the following link - <u>Cardinham School - Attendance</u>. There is one part that we would like to bring your attention to...

"Illness usually appears as a block of time off school. We review attendance patterns fortnightly and look for unbroken and broken weeks as a key indicator. We would not usually expect that children would have more than one or two broken weeks in the course of an academic year. Regular broken weeks are a cause for concern and we will offer support to families where there are more frequent broken weeks, in line with our attendance procedures."

A broken week is classed as having been absent for one single session over the course of a week. There are ten sessions in total across a week - one in the morning, one in the afternoon. A pupil will be 'flagged up' during our internal monitoring if they have had two broken weeks within a half term or three broken weeks across a term. In this instance, you will be contacted as per the trust wide guidance. However, there is a supportive undertone throughout the policy. The main aim is to improve attendance by raising expectations and offering support to families. Please get in touch if you have any questions.
